CLARIFICATION REGARDING THE PROPOSED PLAYGROUND

This is just a quick note to add a little clarity to the documents that were sent out to you yesterday – notably the visuals.

The virtual images that were provided by the supplier are simply the best we have in an image form to give everyone a better idea of how the proposed playground would look. Given the mound is not being supplied or installed for us, they do not have a good image of this item. It is shown purely to give an indication of the proposed location and is not a good example of how it will look once finished.

The tunnel and slide are those which already exist in the present playground and would be reutilised in the new area in and on a smooth sloped mound. There would be wooden structural support of the soil around the tunnel openings and a barrier above the openings (similar to the southern opening of the present structure) so as to meet post installation inspection and safety requirements. All materials used would be wood. We can understand why many had concerns regarding the maintenance of a mound constructed as shown... our apologies for not having made this clearer yesterday.

To understand the space shown for the play area, you can use the young flowering cherry up by the roadside fence as an indication. This is shown on the visuals provided. The southern side would run in line with the present play area.
