Rights of Way Report

The footpaths and bridleways are generally in good order, although vigorous plant growth has caused some to become overgrown. At the moment, with the high temperatures and a very active horsefly population, it isn't sensible to go out verge cutting.

I hope to get some mowing done around the village paths in the next week or two, temperatures and flies allowing, and I will be sending an email to the Footpath Wardens to ask them to inspect their tracks and make use of the strimmers if necessary. I hope to arrange for a team of volunteers to help with cutting back the vegetation on ER22, which has become very overgrown, in the near future.

There are a couple of kissing gates which will require some adjustments in the autumn. I am waiting for advice on how to proceed with this task, and again, I hope a small team of handymen will assist.
