Please ensure that you read the rules carefully and note the requirements for each class, as exhibits may be disqualified if they do not match the specification.

RULES

1. All articles entered for the competition in Section 1 must have been grown by the exhibitor, and have been in their possession for at least the 6 weeks prior to the show.
2. No person may exhibit more than one entry in the same class.
3. Single competitor entry only.
4. The Committee reserves the right to visit the garden of the exhibitor at any time.
5. No artificial plant material allowed.
6. All foods made must be home-made.
7. Only clean glass jars allowed for preserves, with no trademarks.
8. All exhibits must be carefully marked, with the name of the preserve/cordial/beer and date of making.
9. For reasons of hygiene, home baking entries should be covered with Clingfilm or presented in clear cellophane bags.
10. Marks will be awarded for presentation.
11. Children's exhibits must be their own, unaided work with minimum supervision from an adult.
12. All entries are to be submitted in/on a suitable container ready to be placed on the judging table.
13. The Committee will take all reasonable care of the exhibits, but will not accept responsibility for loss or damage.
14. Judging will commence at 2.15pm on Sunday 5th September 2021 and the show will be open to the public at 4pm.
15. Exhibits may not be removed until the prize-giving has ended. The Committee reserves the right to dispose of any exhibits or materials not removed by 6pm on Sunday 5th September 2021.
16. All entries must be according to schedule.
17. The decision of the Judges will be final.
18. **PLEASE NOTE** Entries must be accompanied by a completed Entry form, one per person please download from the village website or contact Liz on 811662 or Karen on 810751. Only Easton Royal residents, or pupils of Easton Royal Academy, are eligible for the award of cups.
